

CROSS IN THE WOODS - BINGO HOUSE RULES

1. You must be 18 years old to play bingo. (No one under 18 allowed during bingo.)
2. There is no admission fee but at least one regular book of games must be purchased to play.
3. At or after 5:30 p.m.: 19 players or less (lack of attendance) may be cause to cancel.
4. Attendance at 6 p.m. determines payout; at 6:05 p.m. no one will be admitted as a player - sales of bingo games/accessories are closed.
5. Bingo numbers not needed during a game (N column for postage stamp, for example) may not be called or recorded.
6. You must bingo on the last number called. After the caller has closed the game there can be no more "bingo's".
7. No picking through game packs is allowed.
8. * The master board is the only official board – the light board is not.
9. * It is the responsibility of the player to make known a bingo to the caller/worker before the next number is completely called.
10. All prize money is divided in proportion to the number of bingo's recognized (\$5 minimum).
11. * For coveralls and prizes of \$100 or more, the card/sheet/ticket shall be displayed so that 2 or more players (at another table) can observe the verification process.
12. Paper may not be covered with chips. Each number must be covered with a dauber or light colored crayon; we will not honor any bingo where numbers are not legible.
13. We are not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged articles.
14. No checks – cash only.
15. * No player can cover a card for another player. A worker may cover a player's cards for a short emergency period (not to exceed 5 minutes) but is not responsible for calling a bingo or for a missed bingo.
16. When playing, a newspaper or plastic mat MUST be used or no winnings will be paid.
17. A bingo will not be paid if paper sheets have been cut or altered.
18. * Winning Charity Game Tickets MUST be redeemed 15 days from date last ticket in series is sold. Only winning Charity Game Tickets sold at this location can be redeemed per state law. "Bingo Balls" tickets are played during the Golden Arrow coverall. Ticket sales close at 6.
19. Contingency Plan (for inclement weather, power outages, equipment failure, lack of attendance, or other unforeseen emergencies): in the event that a bingo occasion is to be canceled, it will be announced on the Cross in the Woods bingo hot-line as soon as possible (231-238-8542); in the event that an occasion or game has to be canceled, players will be reimbursed for all unused paper (specials and/or regular games). Players may receive reimbursement by presenting unused paper either at the time the event is canceled or, if conditions make it not possible, then at one of the next three bingo occasions. If the bingo console/machine breaks down, a hand crank bingo cage may be used, but if not and no other means is to be used, then the bingo occasion will be canceled and players reimbursed accordingly.
20. Refund Policy: players who need to leave prior to the start of the first game will be refunded for all purchased papers; players who leave while bingo is in progress will be refunded for all unused papers.
